CHICAGO – NAPERVILLE – QUINCY/HANNIBAL

Come aboard a round trip in a day to Hannibal, MO., boyhood home of renowned author Mark Twain. Settle back in deep cushioned seats in a restored railcar to experience what quality rail travel was like in the 1940's and 1950's. Board at Chicago Union Station or Naperville in the morning. Savor a hearty continental breakfast served at your seat while the Illinois prairie and quaint rural towns drift by big picture windows . A motorcoach will transfer from train to Hannibal. A short tour will highlight Hannibal major points of interest. Visit Twain's Boyhood Home Museum, browse historic Main Street shops, stroll along the scenic park next to the Mighty Mississippi River. Return to the train for a 'Welcome Back' glass of champagne and hors d'oeuvres followed by a light dinner and dessert. Arrival in Naperville or Chicago is late evening.
