DAY 1A&1B, SUNDAY, OCTOBER 15TH





Travelers arrive in New York City, NY to begin the Zephyr Route Tour. Travelers arrange air or rail travel and transfer on their own. Images show two of many airline choices which serve LaGuardia Airport, the closest to the Hilton Double Tree-Chelsea in Manhattan. Travelers arriving by AMTRAK* train at Penn Station will walk 2 blocks to the Hilton Double Tree – Chelsea in Manhattan. Check-in should be before 6PM. Your Tour Manager, Mike Abernethy, will greet all tour members in the lobby area at 6:30PM for a tour briefing. Travelers should make on your own dinner reservations nearby the hotel for after 7PM. Plan to rise early for breakfast and check-out by 9:00 AM to walk 2 blocks to Penn Station.




